

Pro Se Divorce Paperwork

Everything can be submitted when the case is filed but it can be started with only Initial Filing. Any secondary filing would then go straight to Judge Granger's Court Staff.

Provisional Orders are not necessary for any Divorce. It's only if they want a hearing within the 60 days to divide things and figure it out. If they do want it, they will need to submit the Order Setting Provisional Hearing (proposed) and Provisional Order (proposed).
